


- Remove suckers from tomato plants.
- Prune shrubs that bloom on old wood after they are done flowering.
- Be on high alert for insect pests and diseases.
- Use mature compost or aged manure to side-dress plants.
- Prune wisteria after it finishes blooming.

Continue to <u>direct sow</u> the seeds for warm-season vegetables (beans, melons, squash, etc.).

- Ensure that your automatic irrigation system is working properly
- Fertilize your roses.
- Fertilize citrus and avocado trees.
